2018 Triple S Cowboy Church Arena Rules

Adopted 2/20/2018

Triple S has been blessed with a nice facility to be able to use and the goals of the Arena Team are to continue to make improvements and make this a great ministry for our Church and a means of outreach to our community. In order to accomplish these goals we need everyone to help by abiding to the following rules and guidelines and help us all be good stewards of what God has blessed us with.

"Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found trustworthy. 1 Corinthians 4:2

After much prayer and research leadership has decided to only open the arena for Triple S sanctioned events due to liability and other concerns. Before any person is allowed to use the arena to compete or participate and before any horse is allowed on the church property for a sanctioned event, Triple S Cowboy Church must have the following; a current signed release form from the participant (and guardian if under 18 years old) and a current coggins in their possession on all horses.

The arena lights, tractor, Mighty Bucky, Drag Steer, cattle and Smarty team roping sled are only to be used when specific permission is granted by the Elder over Arena Team or Arena Team Leader. **No Exceptions!**

Absolutely no drugs or alcoholic beverages are allowed at any time on Church property including in your personal vehicles and/or trailers.

Absolutely no profanity or inappropriate comments or behavior at any time will be tolerated anywhere on Triple S Church property for any reason.

All trailers must be parked across the bridge at all times.

If a horse must be tied out please make sure it is only tied to pipe top rail at a line post. Do not tie out to panels, bucking chutes, roping chute, bleachers round pen, etc.

Absolutely no horses allowed in front of the main building, in the general parking area, in the bleacher area, cook shack or any other area marked as "No Horses Beyond This Point"

All dogs/pets must be on leashes and/or secured at all times and be up to date on all required vaccines and be able to provide proof if requested. During Stock Dog practice or competition dogs do not have to be physically secured but owner/handler must show the ability to control the dog at all times either verbally or by other means or they will be ask to physically secure them. Immediately after practice or competition all dogs must be physically secured.

Correction of your horse is allowed; however, abuse of any animal and bad sportsmanship will not be tolerated under any circumstances.

Using the Triple S Cowboy Church arena "For Individual Profit" is not allowed. This includes giving lessons for pay, buying or selling horses, team or calf roping practice or jackpots, barrel racing practice or jackpots, or any other activity for payment to an individual.

Open carry of firearms is strictly prohibited on Triple S Church property.

Stallions are not allowed on Church property at any time due to the increased liability concerns.

If you are the last one to leave Church property, make sure all lights are off and close and lock the main gate.

Limit all riding activities to the arena only.

Do not pet, feed, ride, chase or interact with any other dogs, horses or livestock on the property unless it is your animal or is under your care. If livestock is present in the pens, do not enter pens or disturb livestock for any reason. If they do not belong to you leave them alone unless ask to assist by Arena Elder or Team Leader.

If there is a medical emergency for a person contact 911 for assistance immediately, then contact Arena Elder and Arena Team Leader as soon as possible after securing medical help. If there is an emergency with any animal please notify Arena Elder or Arena Team Leader immediately.

Violations of any of the Triple S Arena rules will result in disciplinary action deemed necessary up to and including exclusion of use of the arena. Disciplinary action will be determined on a case by case basis based on biblical principles.

These are not to be considered a complete list of all rules pertaining to the arena. Separate rule sheets will be provided for specific sanctioned and approved events and will be event specific.
